

Student Travel Awards to Attend SBN 2002

Application Deadline: March 8, 2002

The Society for Behavioral Neuroendocrinology is pleased to announce the availability of Student Travel Awards to attend the 2002 annual meeting in Amherst, MA, 26-30 June 2002. These awards are intended for predoctoral and postdoctoral students in good standing attending US and non-US graduate schools. Applicants must be the first author of an abstract submitted for presentation at the meeting. Recipients are expected to attend the pre-meeting workshop "Contemporary Issues in Aggressive Behavior" to be held on June 26, 2002.

In making the awards the committee will consider the record of achievement of the applicant, the potential impact of the award on the applicant's career, and financial need of the applicant. Awards will be distributed across research areas represented by the SBN.

To apply for a travel award, students should send the following:

- 1. Student's C.V. – Please indicate your status as a graduate student or postdoctoral fellow.**
- 2. Copy of student's abstract to be presented at SBN 2002**
- 3. Letter of support from the student's faculty mentor**
- 4. Any other information that bears on the suitability of the candidate for the award.**
