

Student Travel Awards to Attend SBN 2003

Application Deadline: March 8, 2003

The Society for Behavioral Neuroendocrinology is pleased to announce the availability of Student Travel Awards for the 2003 annual meeting in Cincinnati, OH, 25-29 June 2003. Awards are intended for undergraduate, predoctoral, and postdoctoral students in good standing attending US and non-US graduate schools. Applicants must be the first author of an abstract submitted for presentation at the meeting. Recipients must attend the pre-meeting workshop "Functional Genomics in Behavioral Neuroendocrinology" to be held on June 25, 2003. Note: Support for undergraduates has been added this year!

In making the awards the committee will consider the record of achievement of the applicant, the potential impact of the award on the applicant's career, and financial need of the applicant. Awards will be distributed across research areas represented by the SBN.

To apply for a travel award, students should send the following:

- 1. Student's C.V. – Please include your current email address, indicate your status as a graduate student or postdoctoral fellow, and indicate whether or not you are citizen or permanent resident of the U.S. (Note: Citizenship/residency information is used only to determine the source of funds for payment of awards, not eligibility for an award.)**
- 2. Copy of student's abstract to be presented at SBN 2003**
- 3. Letter of support from the student's faculty mentor**
- 4. Any other information that bears on the suitability of the candidate for the award.**
